BRAD ANDERSON BLOCK REPAIR

The first step in repairing an aluminum block such as the Brad Anderson Funny Car block is to remove the damaged area. Damaged sleeves will also be removed at this time. Once the damage area is removed, a solid bar is torqued in the main bore to prevent distortion during welding. The damaged area is either built up with aluminum welding or fabricated aluminum pieces are welded in place. These repairs are often referred to as windows.

Once the areas are repaired, machining is completed to return the block back to original size. This may include new main caps, line boring and honing the mains, new sleeves as required, and decking the block if required.
